Key Facts . . .

- Available for high school graduates, college, and vocational trade school students
- Up to \$30,000 available for awards this year
- Scholarships of \$250 to \$1,000 may be granted
- Eligible applicants: Children, Grandchildren or Spouses of NCBE Members and Employees, or ANYONE pursuing a 'Career in Construction'
- Completed applications are due by 5:00 pm, Friday, April 9, 2010

Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Attached is an application for the North Coast Builders Exchange 2010 Scholarship Program. It contains more information about who is eligible to apply for scholarships, the information that must accompany your application, and the basis for scholarship awards.

Note: Certified Transcripts are a required part of your application - be sure to request them as soon as possible from your High School (or college, if appropriate).

The NCBE Scholarship Committee - comprised of NCBE Members and Professional Educators from the local community - will review all applications and make recommendations for scholarship awards. The NCBE Board of Directors will review all recommendations and announce the final scholarship award winners no later than Wednesday, May 12th.

Scholarship winners will be notified by mail and will be invited to an awards presentation to be scheduled later this summer.

APPLICATION TO THE NORTH COAST BUILDERS EXCHANGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

The program is open to (1) children or grandchildren of the owners, partners, officers or employees of an NCBE member **or** (2) anyone pursuing a career in construction (including, but not limited to, Architecture, Engineering, Surveying, Construction Management, and the Building Trades). Application for scholarship funds will be made by students entering or continuing enrollment in a university, college, community college or trade school. Applicants must also meet the following GPA minimum requirements:

- **Graduating High School Applicants** - Minimum GPA of 2.5 over the last 2 years of High School. Applicants with a lower GPA are invited to submit applications if accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a current teacher or counselor.
- **Currently Enrolled College Students** - Minimum GPA of 2.5 with a minimum of 12 units per semester **or** 8 units per semester within the student's major area of study. No minimum units required for graduate students.
- **Part-time or Extended Education College Students** - Tuition reimbursement is available for students enrolled part-time or in extended education classes at local community colleges or universities. Grade reports, certificates of completion, or similar records of enrollment or progress should be included with applications.
- **Vocational Trade School Students** - Tuition reimbursement is also available for students enrolled in vocational trade schools and apprenticeship programs. Records of enrollment, grade reports, or similar records of progress should be included with applications.

BASIS OF AWARD

Selection of recipients will be on an achievement or merit basis as determined by the application, transcripts (GPA), moral and leadership qualities. Scholarship monies will be distributed directly to the student upon receiving proof of enrollment.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Application to this scholarship program can be made by completing this form and returning it to the office of the North Coast Builders Exchange in care of the NCBE Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship applications and certified transcripts, must be received in the NCBE office by Friday, April 9th (no exceptions due to mailing delays).
